













Instructions

Print your paper doll and her wardrobe on heavy paper. Carefully cut out, or have an adult help you cut out, Mia*, her stand, and all her beautiful clothes.** You can glue your paper doll to cardstock or onto cardboard to keep her strong. For the stand you will want to use cardboard or other sturdy paper.

Cut two small slits in Mia's hair near her shoulders and remove the white space indicated near her right arm to help slip the clothing tabs into to keep her outfits in place.

Fold the stand on the dotted line. Glue or tape to Mia's back. Because Mia's hair is big it will make her top heavy. Ask someone older to help you glue or tape a penny to the stand to keep her upright.

For extra protection, I recommend you spray your pieces with a finishing spray or brush with a layer of enamel or similar product. Be sure to as an adult to help you do this step.

For extra fun, get creative and design your own fashions for Mia. Let your creativity take flight. Use the image on the right as a guide to create your unique wardrobe.

- **Be sure not to cut between Mia's shoes. Leave the white space connecting them so that they will stay on her feet.
